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
Introduction

The Swiss National Day is coming up on the 1st of August, a day when people come together to celebrate Switzerland's independence and values.

At empowermefirst.college we live Swiss values by doing our share to create equal access to quality education for vulnerable school dropouts and other vulnerable groups, find innovative solutions to local challenges and teach our students how to be successful in the work place with high levels of work ethics. We view our 1st August event in Victoria Falls as a great opportunity to raise awareness and funds for our cause and seek partners who want to reach their SDG-goals by supporting our cause.

Background

Education is a fundamental right that everyone should have access to, regardless of their economic or social background. Unfortunately, a significant portion of individuals across the globe do not have access to proper education and thus can't find employment, because they have dropped out of school.




In Zimbabwe a majority of 70% of youths finish 9 years of school¹, yet 60% of 15-to-17year-olds are out of school and without employment, meaning that the dropouts occur during or after lower secondary. Most of these school dropouts are girls from vulnerable backgrounds. Reasons are young marriages, pregnancies or simply lack of funds for fees and uniforms or distances to secondary school. This has become even more urgent

considering the rise in school and examination fees in the country, pushing many underprivileged into unemployment. With no skills they are left to sit at home or sell goods by the roadside. Yet, a number of them have a smartphone!



Rate of youth out of education, training or work

Hundreds of millions of youths in developing and emerging countries may not continue school beyond grade 9, because of lack of financial resources, need to make a living during the day or family life, thanks to their smartphones and our educational system, they can access education wherever they are, whenever they want.

It is upon this background that we have established centers in Zimbabwe to support those in need of education as a basic human right.

Main Objective

The objective of empowermefirst is to provide free online education to people who cannot afford to attend traditional educational institutions. The aim is to bridge the education divide and increase access to education for those who are economically or physically disadvantaged, while we collaborate with local schools and ministries and don't accept students who are able to attend government schools.

About empowermefirst

empowermefirst seeks to provide free online education to all individuals, regardless of their geographical location or economic background. Through this project, we have created a user-friendly online learning platform that includes various subjects and courses, ranging from basic literacy to advanced professional skills.





The platform is accessible through desktop and mobile devices and hosts free of charge courses. We are also collaborating with existing educational institutions and subject matter experts to provide high-quality course content. Additionally, we offer mentorship and guidance to learners through digital channels and onsite coaches to ensure the learners receive adequate support throughout their learning journey and to successfully complete their assignments which focus on student-driven, interdisciplinary knowledge innovation methods application, research and and entrepreneurship to tackle the challenges in their

communities such as waste, food security, health and adverse effects of climate change. We have centers in Victoria Falls, Hwange District and Bulawayo where our students gather to access wifi.

This project aims to provide support for 50 vulnerable school dropouts to attain their educational goals. The project will support the students in the following ways:

1. Access to Education

We will provide free education and educational materials to our students from marginalized communities who are unable to afford education.

2. Mentorship and Support

Mentorship will be provided to help students to achieve success in their careers. The program will nurture and empower students with the knowledge and skills required to achieve their dreams.

3. Life Skills Training

Students will be provided with education on life skills such as health, entrepreneurship, communication, leadership, problem-solving, and teamwork.

Event

We are organizing a fundraising event to celebrate Swiss National Day on the 1st of August with a dinner, dance, raffle, celebrating the achievements of this Swiss-Zimbabwean collaboration with cultural activities and student performances to attract the Swiss community, Swiss and global tourists and other members of the community and raise funds for 50 of our students.



The event will feature Swiss and Zimbabwean music, local artists. Visitors can learn a traditional dance and there will be an open mike and dancefloor. We will also have a raffle for some amazing prizes, and the money raised will go towards the charity.

Our goal is to raise USD 20,000 from this event, and we believe that with the support of the Swiss, international and local business community, we can achieve this goal of supporting 40 students for one year with a budget given below.

1. Increased access to online learning and improved ICT-skills for vulnerable students. The provision of laptops, computers, and Wi-Fi hotspots to disadvantaged students will increase their access to online learning and help bridge the digital divide.

2. Enhancement of students' educational outcomes. The provision of additional educational resources such as software and online tools will supplement students' learning, increasing their educational outcomes.

3. Positive impact on communities. Education plays a vital role in positively transforming communities. The proposal will create a ripple effect of equitable education, improving the overall community's education standard and promoting sustainable growth. Internships and work experience through semester projects will bring employability to the youth of Victoria Falls and Hwange district.
